The Exceed program is dedicated to education and capacity building in the field of Sustainable Water Management in Developing Countries and, therefore, primarily addresses young scientists.

Thus, the selection of the participants will be made depending on the applicant's

- field of study corresponding to the Exceed main research topics
- age and level of qualification / scientific experience

As the SWINDON/exceed project focuses on capacity and network building amongst its partner universities and regions, it will be of advantage if the applicant is

- born and lives in a Developing Country referring to the DAC list, see http://www.bmz.de/de/zentrales_downloadarchiv/Ministerium/ODA/DAC_Laenderliste_Berichtsjaehre_2014_2016.pdf
- a student of one of the SWINDON/exceed partner universities,
- a student of TU Braunschweig in the field of Sustainable Water Management.

Further criteria for admission to a SWINDON/exceed Summer School are

- a balanced gender ratio, and
- an equal representation of the participant's home countries / regions during the event.

Applications for Exceed Events like Exceed Summer Schools must

- be complete;
- be written in English;
- be a master or PhD student
- contain an elaborated motivation letter showing genuine deep interest in the topic of the summer school as well as the specific benefit of participation for the applicant's study and research.

Applications cannot be considered, if the applicant

- is currently an Exceed scholar;
- at the time of application no more than 6 years should have passed since the graduate gained the last degree.
